

# **South Carolina Region Transmission Planning**

Purpose of this meeting is to identify Economic Planning Scenarios for the SCRTP to look at for this years study.

In the economic planning studies, run the transfers selected, review for any constraints, pursue solutions for identified constraints, and develop cost estimates.

Currently 3 requests for studies—all from Santee Cooper’s Wholesale Marketing:

SC to CPLE 500 MW

SC to SOCO 200 MW

SC to Duke 500 MW

The three scenarios were submitted prior to today’s meeting.

The transmission planning personnel of SC and SCE&G left the meeting so the stakeholders could discuss further requests.

Upon returning, two additional economic studies were requested; by Bob Beadle of NCEMC. These were to be categorized as “wind type studies” with the following:

Based on the 2020 model and base case:

500 MW transfer with 250 MW injection of wind at Myrtle Beach area and 250 MW injection at Charleston/Edisto area. The first transfer will be to PJM.

500 MW transfer with 250 MW injection at MB and 250 MW injections at Charleston/Edisto area. The second transfer will be to Southern.

Kale Ford on Reliability Studies—SERC LTSG/ CTPCA

Phil Kleckley on ERAG Studies.

Clay Young on Interchange Agreement Studies—status of current study between SC AND SCE&G in the Johns Island area. And the three party study with SC/SCE&G/SOCOC.

Jim Peterson on an update on Transmission Investment in the Southeast—2010

Clay Young –briefed the SCRTP on the current status of Eastern Interconnection Planning Collaborative (EIPC)

Clay Young led a brief discussion of the SCRTP website.

Next meeting activities-- combine the next two meetings—if so, each company will present their current transmission plan as well as the results from the economic planning studies.
